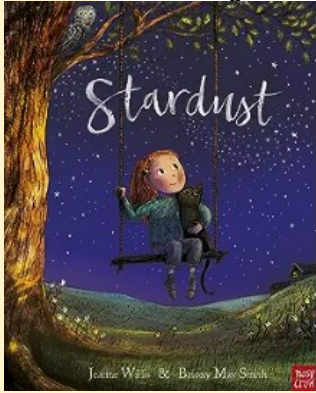

7. Find out why exercise is important to keep our bodies healthy

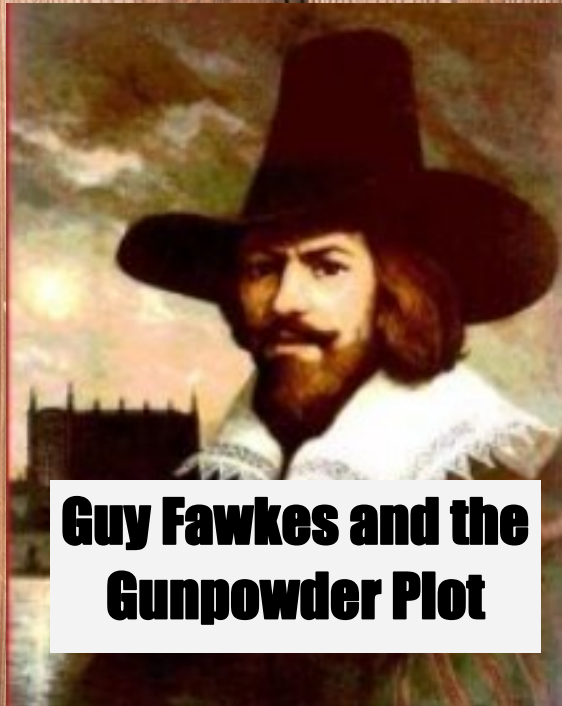
Computing
