Dear Parents

**Morfa Bay Trip  
2nd April - 5th April**

We shall be holding a residential meeting for parents on 18<sup>th</sup> March at 3.15 p.m.

As the date comes ever closer we have prepared a guide to the type of clothing required. Even though we are all hoping for dry, warm weather it is also important to take warm and waterproof clothing.

**The basics** - 1 Sleeping bag and pillow and pillowcase;  
Sufficient warm socks and underwear;  
2 pairs of sturdy shoes or trainers, 1 old pair to be worn in water;  
Night-clothes;  
Towels and Toiletries - soap, flannel, toothbrush, shampoo, hairbrush (towels are not provided).

**Clothes for daytime activities** - 2 Beach towels;  
swimming costume  
3 pairs of trousers or jogging bottoms (1 has to be long trousers);  
Flip flops/pool sandals essential for sea activities;  
1 pair of wellington boots for orienteering;  
3 T-shirts, shirts, blouses (1 has to be long sleeved);  
2 pairs of shorts  
1 thick sweater;  
2 sweatshirts;  
A waterproof anorak/jacket/or trousers);  
2 bin liners for muddy and wet items;  
Plastic mug for hot chocolate and evening drinks;  
**Disco clothing for the last evening.**

**PLEASE DO NOT BUY NEW CLOTHES FOR THIS TRIP! THE CLOTHES TAKEN SHOULD BE OLD AS THEY COULD BE RUINED.**

**Other useful items** - Pens and pencils;  
Torch; Drinks Bottle;  
Plasters;

**Cameras** - we will be taking the school digital camera with us and copies will be produced on a CD for purchase from school. This is probably the cheapest and easiest way to have a pictorial record of our visit without the extra responsibility of children with their own cameras.
