Gryffindor Class – “The Tudors”

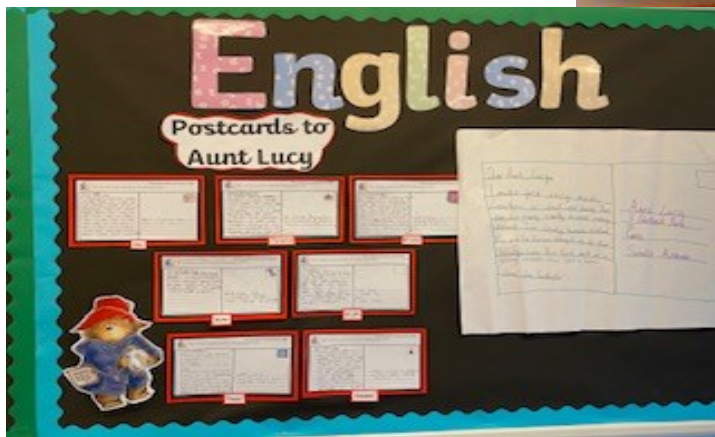
