Interventions & resources: Nesy; Sound Foundations phonic training – Bearing Away, Apples and Pears; Precision Teaching. See main policy.

Early Identification by Class Teacher and referral to SENCo

Assessment by SENCo – referral to outside agencies as necessary.

What does the school do if my child has SEN/D?

Individual education plans to set targets for teaching and learning.

What happens if my child has a statement/EHCP? Regular person-centred review for provision and support.

Tracking children with SEN/D to ensure progress and support in place

Monitoring and reviewing needs through structured conversations

If my child needs additional support beyond their education speak to Speak to Mrs Dowle

What additional service providers does the school access to meet the needs of our children?

Educational support from Advisory Teaching Service, Positive Behaviour Support and Occupational Therapy Service.

Educational Psychology; Service and Targeted Support team.

Alternative Provision School for behavioural and well-being support.

Speech and Language Therapy; School Nursing Team; Paediatrician; Children and Young Peoples Service.

Teaching strategies :Assess, Plan, Do and Review to support progress.
